 - The drive is a good way for the scouting community to get involved and make connections with the local and surrounding communities.

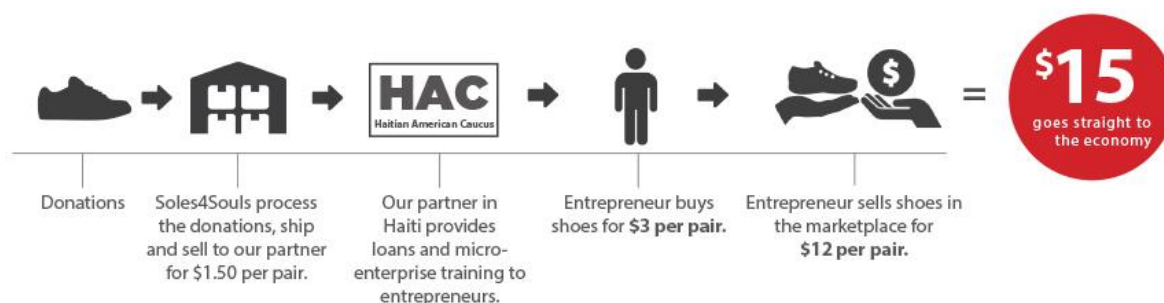


Soles4Souls Micro-enterprise Program

We help those devastated by poverty attain sustainable employment through our micro-enterprise program. It's a huge part of our mission: "Wearing Out Poverty"

What is micro-enterprise?

If we break the word down, we know that *micro* means *small*. *Enterprise* means *business*. Soles4Souls is essentially helping people in economically disadvantaged nations develop small businesses. In places like Haiti, as well as several countries in Africa and Central and South America, jobs, as we know them are very hard to come by. We help them start small businesses so they can generate income to support their family. We achieve this goal by providing micro-entrepreneurs (small business owners) with a constant supply of quality, used product (shoes and clothes) that they can turn around and sell at their local markets. A good example of how our current model works is our program in Haiti:



Shoes are in high demand for micro-enterprise programs because they are universally needed and valued, can be easily bartered for other goods, and are easy to transport and sell. One very important aspect of this system is that Soles4Souls helps ensure a steady flow of inventory – that is, shoes we collect being delivered regularly to our partner. If we don't collect and distribute enough shoes, the ultra-small business operators have nothing to sell. And that can mean having nothing to eat.
