What every Cub Parent attending Haunted Weekend needs to know.....

Registration and Check-in is by Pack, we will only check you in by Pack with the Unit Leader, please arrive as a group or wait until your group is all there before checking in.

1. Bring a tent, one change of weather appropriate clothes, sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, towel, poncho/rain gear and FLASHLIGHTS. Remember this is only a one night campout.
2. Do not wear open- toed shoes or Crocs. Tennis shoes or hiking boots only.
3. There will be concessions (popcorn, cotton candy, & drinks) and a Photo Booth at the Carnival. Please bring extra money if you would like. The Cary Camp Trading Post will be open during this event.
4. Campfires in the campsites are ONLY allowed in the fire rings.
5. Buddy System at all times.
6. No Driving in camp. Cars should be parked in the parking lot when you arrive and should not move until you leave camp.
7. Everyone should be out of camp by 11:00am after checking out.
8. Extra food in the campsites will attract bugs and wildlife and is highly discouraged.
9. Coolers are discouraged. This is only a one night camp out. No alcohol is allowed on BSA property.
10. Supper and Breakfast are on rotation. Everyone does not have to be there as soon as it starts. Please eat and move on because we have a large number of people to feed.
11. Class A uniform for Breakfast please. Causal or Class B during the Carnival Night.
12. BSA Physicals are required (parts A & B).

Leader Registration Information

1. Register on CampMaster by selecting which session of the Haunted Weekend your pack wishes to attend. We need you to come as a pack. If our pack doesn't arrive together please have your families wait in the parking lot until your complete group is there, (at least the unit leader). We understand there may be some exceptions, and we'll work with these as much as possible.
2. Collect your Scouts' and families' money and medical forms. Parents will need medical forms also. These forms only require parts A & B. If you have a balance due at registration please make 1 payment as a pack.
3. Place all your medical forms in a manila envelope or a folder. You will turn these in as you sign in at camp.
4. All the things you and your families need to bring, including tents and such, are listed in the *"What Every Cub Parent Needs to Know"* document (found on CampMaster).
5. The Early Bird Cost for this event is \$12.50 per person which includes all events, supper, and breakfast. The Early Bird Date is October 16, 2015.
6. Please register on CampMaster prior to October 21, 2015. If there are any changes to your registration, please let the Scout Office know ASAP.
7. Extra food and coolers are discouraged. Remember you have a lot of new families in your packs, and you should remind them that **ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED ON BSA PROPERTY.**
8. Supper and breakfast are on rotation. Everyone does not have to be there as soon as it starts. Please eat and move on because we have a large number of people to feed. This is a Family Campout we will be eating in the pavilion off of the Dining Hall.
