DRESS-A-DOLL

The sweep of the skirt in history

It's the second oldest garment known to man – after loincloths. And in ancient times both men and women wore them. What's easier than wrapping a piece of fabric around your waist? Working women at the turn of the century tucked their shirtwaists into long skirts. Chanel helped liberate women from their corsets with no-nonsense skirts that skimmed the knee, paired with smart jackets. Wartime skirts were short on fabric, but the postwar years were heralded by Dior's New Look that had yards of fabric in its skirts. The sporty separates of the 1950s gave women choices: wide puffy skirts with crinolines and straight skirts, some with a side slit for easy movement.



Midcentury style saw hemlines rise and fall. Who among us did not own a mini-, a midi-, or a maxi- skirt? I remember fondly the little cotton wrap skirt of the 1970s which was usually floral and was paired with a solid color T-shirt. Christian Lacroix's pouf balloon skirt of the 1980s was wildly popular and widely copied in that high-flying decade. By the 1990s, the long pencil skirt hobbled onto the scene and was the go-to outfit for working women. Recent summers have seen young women with skirts that have it both ways: short in front, long in back.
