


Denver North High School All-City Chess Challenge

Divisions: K-2 grade, 3-4 grade, 5-6 grade, and 7-12 grade (this in a non-rated tournament, USCF membership is not required) Age sections may be combined or modified if necessary

Times: Check-in 8:30-9:00 a.m. Player meeting (all competitors must attend) at 9:15 a.m. Four games – First game is at 9:30 a.m. *This is a non-elimination tournament – all players will participate in four rounds.* The tournament will end at approximately 1:30 p.m.

Free Adult Chess Lessons: Chess coaches will provide free lessons to adults between 10:45 a.m.-12 p.m.

Prizes: Medals awarded to the top 3 finishers in each division and participation awards will be given to all players.
