

#### CAGT DISTINGUISHED STUDENT AWARDS 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR

Colorado Association for Gifted and Talented (CAGT) is pleased to announce the **CAGT Distinguished Student Awards** program for the 2014 – 2015 school year. This awards program is designed to recognize distinguished achievement in academics, leadership, or the arts, in children ages 7-18. This year the awards program has expanded. Three children for the state of Colorado will be named CAGT Distinguished Students. One student for the Junior Division, ages 7-9, one student for the Senior Division, ages 10-12, and new this year, one student for the Masters Division, ages 13-18. Junior and Senior Division winners will receive a \$500.00 cash scholarship and a CAGT Certificate of Excellence. The Masters Division winner will receive a \$500.00 Master Grant and a CAGT Certificate of Excellence.

CAGT disseminates information to teachers and to parents about this awards program that helps to connect the program for teachers or parents who may want to select students for this honor. Teachers and/or parents select students during the school year and the awards are presented at the CAGT annual conference the following school year. This year's award winner will be presented to the public at the fall conference. CAGT will publish the name of the Distinguished Student winners in the association newsletter, The Kaleidoscope and the winning students will be featured on the CAGT Web site.

CAGT believes that the **CAGT Distinguished Student Awards Program** will inspire children to achieve to their fullest potential; it will highlight high-ability students and draw attention to the educational needs of our state's gifted and talented students.

The following pages contain the award parameters, the nomination procedures, application forms and important dates for the 2014-2015 awards program for all three divisions.

#### AWARD PARAMETERS

- One CAGT Distinguished Student Award recipient will be selected for the Junior Division, ages 7-9 one recipient for the Senior Division, ages 10-12, and one recipient for the Masters Division, ages 13-18.
- Applicants for the Junior Division must be age 7-9 on October 1, 2014. Applicants for the Senior Division must be age 10-12 on October 1, 2014.
  Applicants for the Masters Division must be age 13-18 on October 1, 2014.
- Applicants may demonstrate excellence in one or more of the following areas: visual or performing arts, academic achievement, or leadership.
- The award consists of a \$500.00 cash scholarship or Master Grant and a CAGT Certificate of Excellence for all divisions and recipients.

#### NOMINATION PROCEDURE

#### Nomination Procedure

- 1. CAGT will accept self-nominations and nominations from parents, teachers, students, and community and civic groups.
- 2. All announcements about the awards may include reference to the open nomination process.

#### Selection Criteria

- 1. Students must be age 7-9, age 10-12, or 13-18 on October 1, 2014 to be considered in their division.
- 2. Outstanding student accomplishment may be in one or more of the following areas: academics, visual or performing arts, or leadership.
- 3. Student applicants must submit a composition describing (a) the activity or interest area for which the student is being nominated; (b) how the student got interested/involved in the activity; (c) what impact the activity has had on the student OR on others; and (d) how the student's future plans and goals have been affected by this activity or interest area.
- 4. Applications must include at least one letter of recommendation from someone other than a nominee's family member, explaining why the student nominee is deserving of the award, what sets him or her apart from other students, and how the nominee is impacting the student or others.

#### All of the following items must be submitted for the student to be considered:

- 1. *Fully completed* Student Selection Form (See attached).
- 2. Student composition that addresses the candidate's achievements and aspirations (maximum 750 words).
- 3. Letter(s) of recommendation.
- 4. Current photo of the student (no photocopies school photo preferable).
- 5. A signed release form completed by a parent or guardian. (See attached).

#### Submission to CAGT

- 1. A selection committee will review the applications and make awards based on merit.
- 2. Selection of the award winners and notification to all students will be completed by September 1, 2015
- 3. The award winners for the state of Colorado will receive a CAGT Certificate of Excellence and a \$500.00 cash scholarship or Master Grant.
- 4. The award winners will be presented to the public at the annual CAGT conference in October.
- 5. Materials submitted in the nomination packet cannot be returned. CAGT suggests you keep a copy of the submitted paperwork.
