The Word of the Lord truly is living and active. Hebrews 4:12

I live among thousands of people who have never once heard the truth of Jesus, so much of my response to scripture is interceding for my neighbors. Oftentimes I am led to pray for Muslims with every verse in a passage. I hope this example provides inspiration for you to pray for those who have little or no access to the Gospel.

Psalm 2 (English Standard Version)

1 Why do the nations rage
and the peoples plot in vain?
2 The kings of the earth set themselves,
and the rulers take counsel together,
against the Lord and against his Anointed, saying,
3 "Let us burst their bonds apart
and cast away their cords from us."

I pray for the leaders of the countries in the Middle East, both political and religious, that they would be led by the Holy Spirit and God's purposes would be fulfilled.

4 He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord holds them in derision.5 Then he will speak to them in his wrath, and terrify them in his fury, saying,6 "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill."

The Lord is the supreme ruler of all nations. Everything that happens passes through his hands. **I pray** the leaders of the Arab world, both religious and political, would recognize God's rule.

7 I will tell of the decree: The Lord said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you.

I pray that the veil blinding their hearts would be torn and that Muslims all over the world would respond to the truth of Jesus by the thousands. I pray that believers throughout the Arab world would be bold in their witness of this truth.

I pray for more laborers in the vineyard of Christ. I pray that the nations of the Middle East would become the heritage of Christ and known for being a place of the Spirit of God rather than Islam.
