Directions to Camp Fellowship

Camp Fellowship is located off Hwy. 72, about 20 miles west of Clinton and 8 miles east of Greenwood. There is a green highway sign at 72 and Whitten Road, along with a sign to the camp. The camp is about a mile down Whitten Road on the right.

From Columbia area: I-26 West to exit 54, left on Hwy. 72 to Whitten Road.

From Abbeville and Greenwood area: SC 72 East to Whitten Road.

From Laurens area: US 221 West to SC 72, left on 72, and almost immediate right on Whitten Road.

From Aiken area: North on Hwy 19 to 191 to Johnston. From Johnston take 121 to Saluda; 39 from Saluda through Chappells to Cross Hill. Left on Hwy 72 at Cross Hill toward Greenwood. Go 3.8 miles and turn left at the sign for Camp Fellowship (Whitten Road). If you cross Lake Greenwood, you've missed the turn! Go back.

OR

Hwy. 19 to merger with US 25. US 25 to Greenwood. Right at ByPass 25/221 stoplight (Food Lion). Continue about 4.5 miles to 72/221/178 stoplight (CVS). Continue on 72/221 about 8 miles to Whitten Road. Right on Whitten Road.
