Approved & Built**



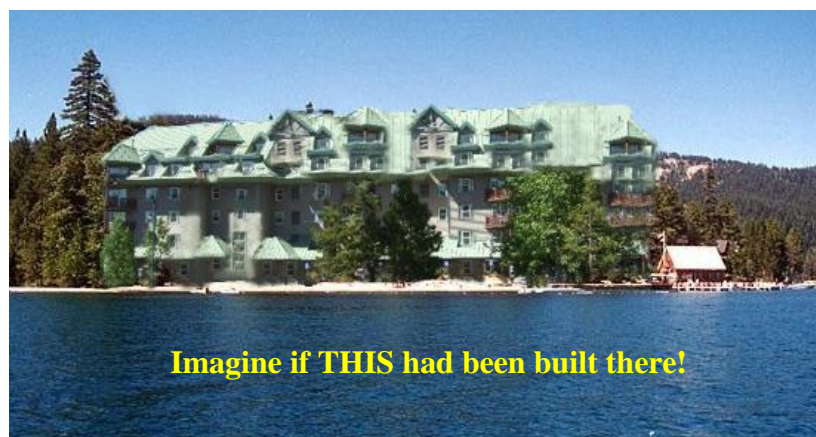
1950's:
Tahoe Keys built, destroying Lake Tahoe's largest natural filtration system



1950's & 1960's:
Casinos began to emerge, and continue to expand for decades, forever marring views of Lake Tahoe and the Basin

**1950's – 1980 –
Proposed, *NOT* Approved**

A major resort hotel roughly 7-8 stories in height at Chambers Landing*



Other proposals fought off by concerned citizens and groups:

- Condos covering hundreds of acres in Meeks Bay
- A 4-lane Highway across the mouth of Emerald Bay

Approved after shift in TRPA towards
Pro-Development**

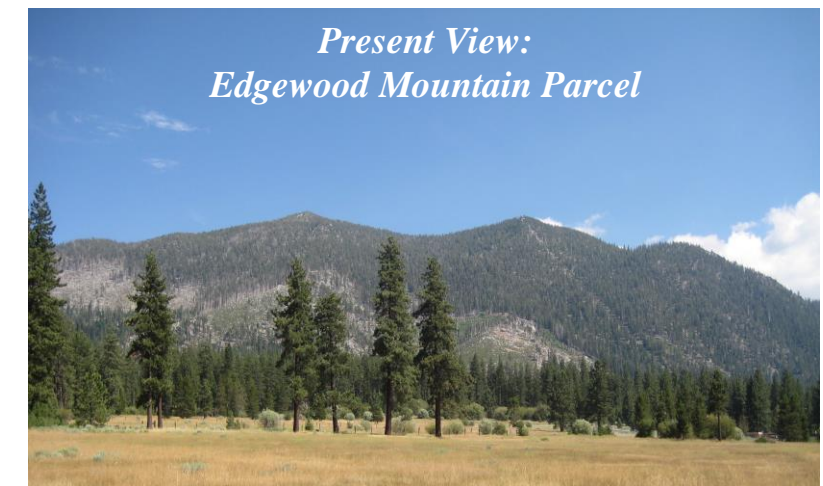
Homewood Mountain Resort Expansion, 2011
