**Caltrans is doing road improvement work on State Highway 89 from the "Y" in South Lake Tahoe to Cascade Road north of Camp Richardson.**

### Project Details

- \$25 million project
- Construction May 2015 – Spring 2017
- 1.1 miles of construction on the four-lane highway
- 4 miles of construction on the two-lane highway

### Construction Schedule

- Off-Peak Season: Around the clock from 10 p.m. Sunday to 11 a.m. Friday
- Peak Season: 9 p.m. Sunday to 7 a.m. Monday, then 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday

### Project Benefits

- Stormwater runoff collection and treatment
- Curb, gutter, and sidewalk additions in four-lane section
- Widening of the two-lane highway to provide 4-foot wide paved shoulders
- Pedestrian-activated beacon and lighting addition at Camp Richardson crosswalk
- New highway pavement surface
