CLUE #3

You will make FIVE of these blocks!!

The BLOCK!

Candy Corn!!!! In Flying Geese blocks!! EASY - FUN!!!!!!

<u>All five of these blocks have four Candy Corn Flying Geese units</u>. You will need to make a total of twenty of these fun Candy Corn blocks.


To make these twenty Candy Corn Flying Geese units, CUT:

2 – 1" x wof strips <u>each</u> of your white, yellow, and orange fabrics (total of six fabric strips)

Sew these strips together to make two strip sets. Sub-cut at 3 $\frac{1}{2}$

Cut 20 – 2" x 3 ½" strips.

Set these aside for now. These strips will later become the Candy Corn Flying Geese units.



To make ONE block CUT:

4 - 2" x 3 ½" strips of Fabric #1 (for a second set of Flying Geese units).

16 – 2" squares of Fabric #2 (the Background Fabric for the block).

Use four of your Candy Corn Flying Geese units and your 4 - 2" x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric #1 to make your eight flying geese units for this block.


Draw a diagonal line from corner-to-corner on the back of the 16 - 2" squares of Fabric #2 (the Background fabric for the block).

Lay a 2" square of Fabric #2 face-to-face on the LEFT side of all 8 - 2" x 3 ½" strips (four of the Candy Corn strips and four of the Fabric #1 strips).

Sew a seam directly on the diagonal line on all eight strips.

Cut through both fabrics 1/4" from the seam. Press open.

Repeat the same process on the RIGHT side of your strips.




Pair up your flying geese blocks as shown sewing the "solid" flying geese units to the TOP of the Candy Corn flying geese units. Fabric #2
