## Clue \#3



You will make FOUR of these blocks!!

## The BLOCK!

Who doesn't love a house block? This is one of my favorite blocks! You'll have fun constructing your four little houses! :)

To make ONE block,
For the BACKGROUND, CUT:
1-1 $1 / 4$ " $\times 61 / 2 "$ strip
3-1 $1 / 4$ " $\times 2$ " strips
2-2" squares
For the ROOF, CUT:
1-2" x $6 \underline{1 ⁄ 2 "}$ strip Fabric \#1
For DOOR and CHIMNEYS, CUT:
$1-2 " \times 21 / 2$ " strip of Fabric \#2
2-1 $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares of Fabric \#2
For HOUSE, CUT:
2-1" x $31 / 2$ " strips of Fabric \#3 (outside strips)
2-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ " strips of Fabric \#3 (above window strips)
2-1 $1 / 2$ " squares of Fabric \#3 (below window squares)
2-1 $11 / 4$ " x $31 / 2$ " strips of Fabric \#3 (sides of the door)
1-1 $1 / 2$ " $\times 2$ " strip of Fabric \#3 (above door)
For WINDOWS, CUT:
2-1 $1 / 2$ " $\times 2$ " strips of Fabric \#4

## HOUSE CONSTRUCTION:

To construct the roof, take the $2-2$ " squares of Background Fabric. Draw a pencil line on the back of the squares from corner to corner. Place a square face-to-face on the left side of your $2 "$ x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Roof Fabric (Fabric \#1). Sew directly on the pencil line. Cut $1 / 4$ " from your seam and press open. Repeat on the right side of your roof.


To construct the Chimney Strip of your house, sew a Chimney Fabric (Fabric \#2) $11 / 4$ " square to one of the $3-11 / 4 "$ x 2 " strips of Background Fabric. Sew another of the $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 2$ " strips of Fabric \#2 to the other side of the $11 / 4$ " square of Chimney Fabric. Now sew the second $11 / 4 "$ square of Chimney Fabric to the other side of this strip. And, finally sew the last $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 " strip of Background Fabric to this Chimney Strip.
$\square$


Sew this Chimney Strip to the top of your Roof Strip.


Sew the $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Background Fabric to the top of this strip.


To construct the Door Section, sew the 2" x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Door Fabric (Fabric \#2) to the $11 / 2 " \times 2$ " strip of House Fabric (Fabric \#3).

Sew a $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $31 / 2 "$ strip of House Fabric (Fabric \#3) to BOTH sides of the Door strip. Set aside.

To construct the Window Sections, sew a $11 / 2$ " x 1" strip of House Fabric to the TOP of both $11 / 2 " \times 2 "$ Window Fabric strips (Fabric \#4).


Sew a $11 / 2$ " square of House Fabric to the BOTTOM of both Window Strips.


Sew a Window Strip to BOTH sides of your DOOR Strip.


Sew a 1 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ strip of House Fabric to BOTH sides of your House Unit.


Sew your House Unit to your Roof Unit.
You have done it!! Congrats!! Make four of these Houses! : )
