## CLUE \#4

## You will make FIVE of these blocks!!

## The BLOCK!

This is an easy yet fun block to make - four snowballs in each block! Each block uses two fabrics to create a "yin-yang/positive-negative" effect.

## To make ONE block CUT:

$2-3^{1 / 2 "}$ squares of Fabric \#1
$8-1^{1 / 4} "$ squares of Fabric \#1
$2-3^{1 / 2 "}$ squares of Fabric \#2
$8-1^{1 / 2} 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric \#2
Draw a diagonal line from corner-to-corner on the back of all $16-1 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares ( 8 of Fabric \#1, 8 of Fabric \#2).

Place a $1^{1 / 4}$ " Fabric \#1 square face-to-face in the corner of a $3^{1 / 2}$ " square of Fabric \#2.
Sew directly on the pencil line.
Trim $1 / 4$ " from the seam and press open.
Repeat on the other three sides of your block.
Make another block exactly the same.


Place a $1^{1 / 4}$ " Fabric \#2 square face-to-face in the corner of a $3^{1 / 2}$ " square of Fabric \#1. Sew directly on the pencil line.
Trim $1 / 4$ " from the seam and press open.
Repeat on the other three sides of your block.
Make another block exactly the same.


Lay out your four blocks and sew together.


## YOU did it!

Make five of these snowball blocks. They will measure $6^{1 / 2}$ " square to finish at 6 " square.
