

## Halloween Mystery Quilt



### CLUE #4

**You will make FIVE of these blocks!!**

#### **The BLOCK!**

This is an easy yet fun block to make – four snowballs in each block! Each block uses two fabrics to create a “yin-yang/positive-negative” effect.

#### **To make ONE block CUT:**

**2 – 3 ½” squares of Fabric #1**

**8 – 1 ¼” squares of Fabric #1**

**2 – 3 ½” squares of Fabric #2**

**8 – 1 ¼” squares of Fabric #2**

Draw a diagonal line from corner-to-corner on the back of all 16 – 1 ¼” squares (8 of Fabric #1, 8 of Fabric #2).

Place a 1 ¼” Fabric #1 square face-to-face in the corner of a 3 ½” square of Fabric #2.

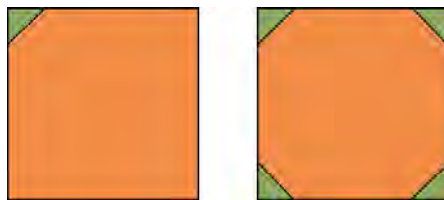
Sew directly on the pencil line.

Trim ¼” from the seam and press open.

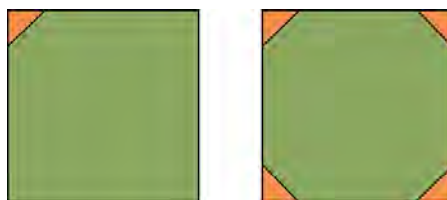
Repeat on the other three sides of your block.

Make another block exactly the same.

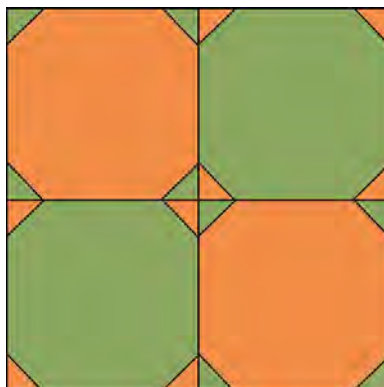
## Halloween Mystery Quilt



Place a 1 1/4" Fabric #2 square face-to-face in the corner of a 3 1/2" square of Fabric #1.  
Sew directly on the pencil line.  
Trim 1/4" from the seam and press open.  
Repeat on the other three sides of your block.  
Make another block exactly the same.



Lay out your four blocks and sew together.



**YOU did it!**

**Make five of these snowball blocks. They will measure 6 1/2" square to finish at 6" square.**
