Halloween Mystery Quilt



CLUE #4

You will make FIVE of these blocks!!

The BLOCK!

This is an easy yet fun block to make – four snowballs in each block! Each block uses two fabrics to create a "yin-yang/positive-negative" effect.

To make ONE block CUT:

- 2 3 1/2" squares of Fabric #1
- 8 1 1/4" squares of Fabric #1
- 2 3 1/2" squares of Fabric #2
- 8 1 1/4" squares of Fabric #2

Draw a diagonal line from corner-to-corner on the back of all $16 - 1 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares (8 of Fabric #1, 8 of Fabric #2).


Place a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric #1 square face-to-face in the corner of a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square of Fabric #2. Sew directly on the pencil line.

Trim 1/4" from the seam and press open.

Repeat on the other three sides of your block.

Make another block exactly the same.

Halloween Mystery Quilt




Place a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric #2 square face-to-face in the corner of a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square of Fabric #1. Sew directly on the pencil line.


Trim ¼" from the seam and press open.

Repeat on the other three sides of your block.

Make another block exactly the same.



Lay out your four blocks and sew together.



YOU did it!

Make five of these snowball blocks. They will measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to finish at 6" square.
