RWIPS will have about 2000 North American native plants available. We will feature Rhode Island and New England natives particularly suited to our climate and soil conditions.

There will be plants for all growing conditions, Sun, Shade, Dry, Moist, Woodland, Meadow, and Coastal. We have a great collection of fragrant Native Azaleas, many grown from seed by RIWPS Seed Starters. You will find an extensive variety of ferns that flourish in Rhode Island woodlands. Starting with Spring Ephemerals, like Bloodroot, Trillium, and Virginia Bluebells right through colorful summer blooms and shrubs with great fall color and berries, you will find it all. Bring your shopping list along.

Using native plants such as the Milkweeds, Monarda, and Cardinal Flower will attract birds and butterflies to your garden.

RIWPS wildflower experts will be present to answer questions on growing native plants and assisting you in the right selection of plants for your home landscape.

Many of the plants in our sale are not found in most local garden centers and nurseries. It is the best Native Plant sale in Rhode Island. Come early for the best selection.
