William Feasley's guitar has been described by the Washington Post as "sounding, in the words of Segovia, like a small orchestra in its variety of colors..." In this concert William's guitar is complethree additional by instruments - a theorbo (a six foot long member of the lute family popular during the baroque era), a five course baroque guitar and a 19th century guitar. The repertoire will range from fantasies and dances for the baroque guitar and theorbo by Spanish and Italian composers, works by an 18th century Peruvian abbot and Fernando Sor, -one of the best known quitar composers of the early 19th century - to passionate tangos, fantasias and sonatas recently for William Feasley by American and Latin America composers.
