## **Program Descriptions**

### **Aquarium Talk**

The marine aquariums in the Toms Cove Visitor Center are just a "drop in the bucket" of the diversity of life surrounding the island. Get a peek at who is swimming around out there with you!

Before there was pony penning, there was "sheep penning." Discover how sheep, brought here in the 1600's, played a role in the lives of the island folks. Touch wool. See how a spinning wheel works. Imagine living here during another time. Join us anytime during the 1 hour window.

Gather 'round the ranger and today's mystery "guest." Learn the life and lore of a special Assateague resident during this informal discussion.
