

CGSA Announces its 2015 Scholarships

The Canadian Golf Superintendents Association (CGSA) announced the recipients of the 2015 Scholarship and Presidents Scholar Awards as part of the Bayer CGSA/OGSA Awards Luncheon on January 12th, 2016 in Toronto.

The CGSA Scholarship Program supports "CGSA student members" attending educational programs as a means of enhancing their knowledge and skills for the turfgrass profession. This financial assistance is meant to assist members in becoming better qualified for their current employment or other opportunities within the turfgrass profession.

This assistance is available to all CGSA student members who are currently enrolled in at least the second year of a recognized turfgrass program of two (2) years duration (or longer). One year equipment technician course students are also eligible.
