Pay Your 2014-2015 Membership Dues by May 15, 2014 for a Chance to WIN a \$2,000 2015 Conference Package!

Future Superintendent of the Year Award ~ Deadline Date is April 30th

This award is offered to student members of CGSA who are completing their graduating year in a CGSA recognized program. **Please note that the award presentation is currently being reviewed and should be finalized in the very near future.**

Superintendent of the Year Award ~ Deadline Date is May 1st

This title is awarded to a superintendent who is nominated by peers and chosen by a peer-group selection committee as a knowledgeable and competent member of the profession who is distinguished in the practice of golf course management. The person chosen by CGSA also receives the Score Golf Award for Superintendent of the Year.

Nominees for this award must be CGSA superintendent members that have been superintendents for a period of at least five years. The deadline for the receipt of these materials is **May 1st**.

President's Scholarship Award – Deadline Date is June 30th

This program will offer two awards of \$1,000 each to be presented annually to two first year, post-secondary students who are the child or grandchild of a CGSA member.

The scholarships will be presented to two applicants that have the highest overall average for their high school graduating year and who are entering the first year of a post-secondary program. Applicants must be the child or grandchild of a CGSA member in good standing. Each applicant is required to provide a transcript of their grades and a 500 word essay outlining why the award is important to them. The essay will only be reviewed if there is a tie. Applications are due at the CGSA office by **June 30th**.

John B. Steel Award ~ Deadline Date is July 1st

This award is presented to an individual chosen by the CGSA Board of Directors who has made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of the profession of Golf Course Superintendent. An individual may be nominated by the Board of Directors of CGSA or by a "Superintendent" member. The deadline for nominations is **July 1st**.
