More Than a Carpenter with Scott Hearn (14 weeks, Session 1 & 2)

But who was this person Jesus? What was unique about Him? What was central to His identity? What did He teach? What did He do? How did He live out His brief 33 years on earth? Lead Like Jesus with LaChelle Neudorfer (7 weeks, Session 1)

The class will feature weekly reading, facilitated discussion and open discussion within the group.

The Shack with Jennifer Lawrence (14 weeks, Session 1 & 2)

Join us to learn, through one man's tragedy, about the Holy Trinity and how each one is just as important and needed for each aspect of our lives. The Shack is a one of a kind invitation that will usher you directly into the heart and nature of God in the midst of agonizing human suffering. This amazing story will challenge you to consider the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in more expansive terms that you may have ever dreamed.

Session 2 Begins October 7th at 6:30 pm:

Minor Prophet with Jennifer Teague (7 weeks, Session 2)

To be honest...when did you last read a book like Obadiah? Or Nahum? Or perhaps the better question is "Have you ever read Obadiah?" or "Where do I find Haggai"? The Minor Prophets form the last 12 books of the Old Testament. Theologian James Montgomery Boice comments on how the Minor Prophets dramatize the character of God as few other books do: "They highlight God's sovereignty ... holiness ... and love In the Minor Prophets, we will hear the voice of God speaking to us in a fresh way ... as individuals and as a spiritual fellowship in the Church." All that is needed for this class is your Bible.

Following Jesus (Biblical Reflections on Discipleship) with Joshua Carr (7 weeks, Session 2)

The twelve exhilarating chapters in this volume explore what it truly means to follow Jesus today. Part One outlines the essential messages of six major New Testament books--Hebrews, Colossians, Matthew, John, Mark, and Revelation. Part Two examines six key New Testament themes--resurrection, rebirth, temptation, hell, heaven, and new life--and considers their significance for the lives of present-day disciples.
