Resurfacing of State Road (SR) 472 from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Beltway to Graves Avenue

PROJECT DETAILS

The improvements on this project include milling and resurfacing of the eastbound and westbound travel lanes and turn lanes of State Road (SR) 472 (Howland Blvd.) from just east of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Beltway to just west of Graves Avenue. The project also includes resurfacing the entry and exit ramps at the Interstate 4 (I-4) interchange to the visible pavement joints, as well as minor drainage, guardrail and signal improvements.

Work on this project may occur during daytime and nighttime hours.

LANE CLOSURES AND DETOURS

Motorists using SR 472 can expect periodic single lane closures, as well as nighttime ramp closures that will require detours. The ramp detours will utilize Orange Camp Road for traffic headed to eastbound I-4 from SR 472, and Saxon Boulevard for traffic headed to westbound I-4.

SAFETY

The FDOT strives to maintain traffic flow as much as possible during construction. Motorists are asked to use caution when traveling through work zones.
