ASQ (Ages and Stages Questionnaire) provides a quick check of your child's development. It's an opportunity to learn about developmental milestones and fun learning activities.



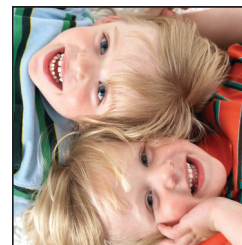
As a parent you are the best source of information about your child. That's why the simple questionnaires are designed to be filled out by you.

Why Check Early, Check Often?

Because a child's first 6 years are critical to a healthy mind and body for life.

Checking on your young child's development helps to:

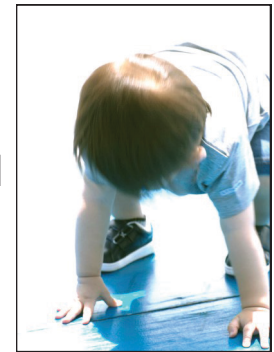
- make sure she is growing and learning well
- identify strengths as well as areas that he may need to practice
- prepare her to be ready to learn in kindergarten
- make sure he is off to the best possible start



What areas of development are being checked?

Communication: what your child understands and what he or she can say.

Gross motor: How your child uses arms, legs and other large muscles.



Fine motor: Your child's hand and finger movement and coordination.

Problem solving: How your child plays with toys and solves problems.

Personal-social: Your child's self-help skills and interactions with others.
