Why Check Early, Check Often?

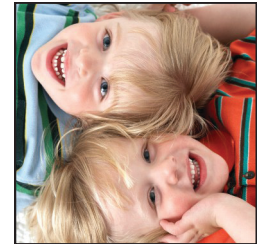
Because a child's first 6 years are critical to a healthy mind and body for life.
