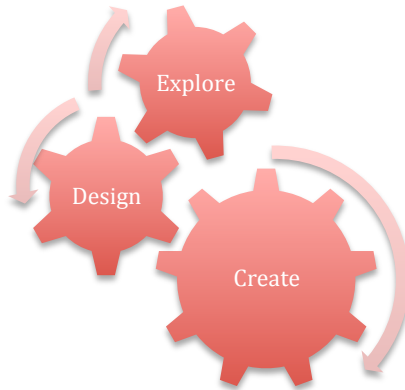


Riverside Innovation Space

Calling all inventors, engineers, tinkerers, and makers! After a successful series of Innovation Space Workshops and Lab Explorations, we are excited to make the Innovation Space available to all Riverside students on a weekly basis.

Who – Riverside Students, accompanied by a parent

When - Tuesdays and Thursdays, 3:15 pm - 4:15 pm

Where - Riverside Innovation Space, Media Center

Starting Tuesday, March 15th, the Riverside Innovation Space will be open from 3:15 – 4:15 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. These open labs will allow students to explore the different tools and components in the Innovation Space, at their own pace and based on their own interests. Topics to explore include 3D design, circuits, robotics, and coding. Students can also continue work on their Genius Hour and Stem Fair projects.

Open labs are available to all Riverside students with a maximum of 15 students per session. Students must be accompanied by their parent or their caregiver. Students will be dismissed after school to parents per the usual process, and parents will bring their children into the lab through the front door. A Riverside staff member will be there to provide support to students and parents. Please note that this is not a class or guided exploration. This is time for students to explore and utilize the Innovation Space with guidance and support from a parent.
