After school personnel have screened the applications, some students will be selected for personal interviews at Jim Burke Ford on Oak Street. School personnel will notify those students selected for an interview. On average, 125 students representing 17 area schools are interviewed each year. The final selection of approximately 10 Ford Dimension representatives and 22 Dream Builders will be based on a point system involving the entire applicant pool and not the individual schools.

Candidates will be scored on the following criteria: Leadership, responsibility, personality, communication skills, commitment, scholastic achievement, grooming, and community and school involvement.
