The Summer Adventure Program offers six weeks of discovery and exploration for children ages 5-9. Summer Adventure meets Tuesday-Thursday from 9:30-12:30, with a different theme each week. Each week includes hands-on activities, outdoor exploration, and a fun mix of history, science, and arts. A morning snack is provided. Children are encouraged to bring a re-useable water bottle.

## 2016 Summer Adventure Sessions

### **Session 1, Shipwrecks & Lifesavers, July 5-7**

Walk in the footsteps of Captain Joshua James and his crew, exploring daily life at the historic Lifesaving Station. We'll learn about Boston Harbor's most amazing storms and shipwrecks, hear stories of courageous rescues, and have a chance to ride the breeches buoy!

### **Session 2, Boston Light: Lighting the Way!, July 12-14**

Celebrating its 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary this summer, Boston Light is a national treasure, America's first lighthouse. We will learn about the history of Boston Light, the children and pets who have called it home, and the science behind its beautiful Fresnel Lens that lights the way into Boston Harbor.

### **Session 3, Pond Yachts, July 19-21**

A great opportunity for young children to build their first model boat-a T12 that sails beautifully. Children will assemble, paint, and rig their vessels from a high quality T12 model boat kit. Launch day is a joy to see!

### **Session 4, Tide Pool Adventures I, July 26-28**

Always a highlight of the summer, we'll explore the wonderful tidal pools within a short walk of the museum, learning to slow down, look closely, and find the wealth of plant and animal life in a single small pool.

### **Session 5, Coast Guard Kids, August 2-4**

A very special celebration of the Town of Hull's recent designation as a national Coast Guard City, we will learn about the important role of the Coast Guard in Hull, from the early lifesavers to today's modern missions.

### **Session 6, Tide Pool Adventures II, August 9-11**

We will continue our exploration of the rich intertidal zone on local beaches, investigating our finds with nets and magnifiers. We'll learn about sea stars, anemones, crustaceans and more! (It is not necessary to have participated in Tide Pool Adventures I to participate in this session).
