Call for Entries

The Sea & Sky Art Show is held annually at the Hull Lifesaving Museum's historic Point Al-
lerton US Lifesaving Station. Sea & Sky celebrates the beauty of our coastal environment
and the richness of the artistic community on the South Shore and beyond.

Submission Guidelines

All media are welcome.

Artists may submit three works of art for consideration in the juried exhibition.

All work must be original, and not previously exhibited at the HLM.

No reproductions (including giclée prints) will be accepted.

Entries must be securely framed (unless the work is not intended to be framed) and wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers. Works not properly prepared for exhibition may be refused.

Works must not be more than 36 inches in any direction.

Unframed work, including sketches and reproduction prints, may be submitted for sale in the art bin. If submitting to the art bin, please provide a complete list of your art bin submissions.

Submission Fee: \$8 members, \$10 nonmembers per submission.

Artists will be notified by email if their work has been selected for the show by Tuesday, January 26, 5 pm. Work not selected for the show may be picked up during normal museum hours, Mon-Thurs, 10 am - 4 pm, or by appointment.

Opening Wine & Cheese Reception, Friday, February 5, 2016, 7 pm.

All artists are invited to attend the opening reception with complimentary admission.

The show will close on Friday, February 27, 2015.

Work may be picked up on Sunday, February 28 from 2-4 pm, or during regular museum hours the following week, Monday - Thursday, 10 am - 4 pm. If you are unable to pick up your work during these hours please make arrangements with a colleague to do so.

Artists receive 70% of the sale price; all prices must be marked on entry form.

Artists delivering work should allow time to complete the entry form at the museum.

Liability and Agreement

LIABILITY: The Hull Lifesaving Museum's trained staff and volunteers will handle all artwork with due care; however, we cannot be responsible for loss or damage. The Hull Lifesaving Museum will not be responsible for work not removed at the times indicated.
