EXPECTANCY FOR THE NEW YEAR!

The 2nd page of this newsletter contains the 2015 Financial Report. We're very thankful to our Father for increasing the funds that came into RHM in 2015. More than 40% of the funds received were designated funds for 3 main targets: persecution-related ministry via the Morning Star, the HOPE Van Project, and the Helpless Widows Project. HOPE continues to be the main recipient of the funds. Keep us in prayer, as inflation continues to rise here. According to national rates (at least what is reported), inflation nationally is down. But I can say definitely that where we are involved in ministry, inflation has been considerably higher over the last year.

Happy to say that finally the new widows home is ready to take in needy women. Only one little problem: we still don't have anyone to care for them. I guess that's not a little problem, huh? But the Lord has led us this far and provided for everything, so definitely He'll provide the helper or helpers needed. We've also had the issue of very needy women who are not willing to move to a totally new village where they don't know anyone. One such example is Lakshmi, the widow who was staying at HOPE, but mentally unsound and wanted to go back to her village, back to lying in the dirt. A sad situation, but nothing we can do but pray she'll be cared for properly, and that her soul will be prepared to meet Him.

Pray for 2 of our oldest HOPE girls, Anusha and Sravanthi, both 20 years old. They have returned to relatives, searching for nursing jobs. Pray they'll walk on faithfully with JESUS.

CHILDREN'S PROFILES

Glory (6-10-02, Morning Star): Glory's family faced persecution in 2007 and 2008. The one in '08 caused them to flee, their home being burnt down and losing everything. They wandered here and there for 4 months trying to survive. Then they tried to return to their village, but Hindus wanted to kill them, so they went to their uncle's village. Came to MS in 2013. Her mother died last year.



Charity (born 9-1-09, HOPE): Comes from a very poor village, her father an alcoholic and often beating the child. The mother was trying to work to provide for her. At 6 years old we can recognize she has had a rough life. Her real name is Thirupathamma, named after a Hindu god. We changed her name to Charity, which seems to make her happy. She's a little wild, but is adjusting to her new home.

Sathish Kumar (born 7-13-09, HOPE): His mother is a Muslim and left the family, taking a daughter with her. The father started drinking more, and is not willing to care for his 2 boys. The grandfather also left years ago, so the grandmother was struggling to work and care for both boys. He's only been with us a few days; needs prayer.

MANNA PROGRAM PROFILES

MANALISHA (Morning Star MP): Her husband (a driver) heard about persecution taking place in their area, so left his job to return home. Walking from the bus station to their home, a mob caught him and killed him. They took his body inside a church, put it together with many church objects, poured kerosene and burnt the church down. Manalisha heard about this and escaped into the jungle with their son and daughter. Now both children are studying. She's working to care for them.



RUTHAMMA (El Bethel MP): She is in her 60's, and has no children. Her husband sent her out of the house around the year 2000 because she came to the Lord and was attending church (she had been saved a few years earlier). She came to Bapatla (same place where the HOPE ministry is located) to stay with relatives. She has some physical problems and is not able to work for any extended time. She stays in an El Bethel church in a town called Karlapalem. She seems to be a strong and prayerful believer, and has been a real asset to the ministry, having her in the church and assisting in different ways.

Below: HOPE School children during a recent assembly. There's more than 180 children in the school now, besides the 30 or so HOPE children that are part of the school (nursery thru 7th grade). Pray that the Lord will help us to establish strong, daily ministry to the children. The academic side is doing fine, but we struggle getting the teaching staff to give more priority to ministering JESUS to them while we have the opportunity.
