

# Shuttle Bus & Relay Exchange Parking Information for Relay Participants



# **Shuttle Bus Schedule**

Shuttle Buses will be available to take you to the relay exchange points and to pick up Relay runners and return them to Frontier Field. We ask that all runners are patient in terms of waiting for the shuttle buses to return you to Frontier Field. The course must be navigated as safely as possible, so your patience will be greatly appreciated. Shuttle buses are only for participants that are wearing their race numbers. No spectators will be allowed on the buses that are designated for the Relay. However, spectators will be allowed on the shuttle buses that are bringing participants to the Starting Line. Every relay point will have water and porta-potties.

## If you are running Leg 1 of the Marathon Relay:

You will be starting at the Start Line on Maplewood Drive. The relay begins at 7:30 am along with the full & half marathon. There will be shuttle buses to the Start Line from Frontier Field for all participants. Shuttle buses to the Start Line will begin at 5:00 am and continue until 7:00 am. You can meet these buses on the corner of Verona Street and Morrie Silver Way (Platt St).

You will finish your leg at the O'Rorke Bridge. You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from the O'Rorke Bridge, or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

Pick Up at the O'Rorke Bridge	<u>Destination</u>
9:00 am	Frontier Field
10:00 am	Frontier Field

## If you are running Leg 2 of the Marathon Relay:

You will be starting at the O'Rorke Bridge. You may arrange your own transportation to this point or take one of the two shuttle buses. You can meet these buses on the North Plymouth Avenue, by the corner of Morrie Silver Way (Platt St). Those buses will be picking up only leg two runners and will leave Frontier Field at **7:00 am**. They will arrive at the O'Rorke Bridge by **7:30 am**.

You will finish your leg at the Maplewood Rose Garden. You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from the Maplewood Rose Garden or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

#### If you are running Leg 3 of the Marathon Relay:

You will be starting at the Maplewood Rose Garden. You may arrange your own transportation to the Maplewood Rose Garden or take one of the two shuttle buses. You can meet these buses on the North Plymouth Avenue, by the corner of Morrie Silver Way (Platt St). Those buses will be picking up only leg three runners and will leave Frontier Field at **7:30 am**. They will arrive at the Maplewood Rose Garden by **8:00 am**.

You will finish your leg at the O'Rorke Bridge. You may arrange your own transportation to pick you up from the O'Rorke Bridge, or you may take one of the following shuttle buses back to Frontier Field:

Pick Up at the O'Rorke Bridge	<b>Destination</b>
11:00 am	Frontier Field
11:30 am	Frontier Field
12:30 pm	Frontier Field

#### If you are running Leg 4 (final leg) of the Marathon Relay:

You will be starting at the O'Rorke Bridge. You may arrange your own transportation or take one of the two shuttle buses. You can meet these buses on the North Plymouth Avenue, by the corner of Morrie Silver Way. Those buses will be picking up only leg four runners and will leave Frontier Field at **8:00 am**. They will arrive at the O'Rorke Bridge by **8:30 am**.

You will finish at the MVP Health Care Rochester Marathon Finish line at Frontier Field. No additional transportation will be provided.

# Parking at Relay Exchange Points

The two Relay exchange points are the O'Rorke Bridge and the Maplewood Rose Garden. If Relay participants prefer to drive to their exchange or get dropped off, there is parking available at both locations. Please see below:

## O'Rorke Bridge

The Relay area can be accessed from Marina Drive (off Pattonwood). Drive to the end of Marina and instead of turning left and going under the bridge, turn to the right and use the parking lot of Voyager Boat Sales. There will be no parking allowed under the bridge or by the docks. Volunteers will be there to assist you with where it is safe to park. See map on website for specific detail of area.

### **Maplewood Rose Garden**

There will be no parking allowed in the lot attached to the Rose Garden. There is a parking lot located on the corner of Driving Park & St. Paul that will have Relay parking. You will take a very short walk over the Driving Park Bridge to get to the Rose Garden. See map on website for specific detail of area.
