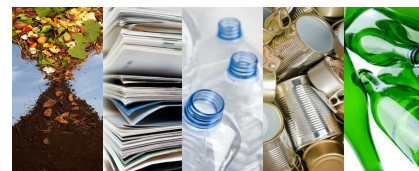

Certification Program is currently offering 40 classroom hours which can be completed over three sessions in less than one year. Courses and Certification Testing
