Course Overview

Day One: Recycling 110 - Recycling and The Law

An overview of Act 101, Act 97, and Act 90 as well as any current news on the legislative front. Discuss the state, county, and local responsibilities for those Acts as well as the pros and cons of authorities. Other discussion topics include legal tools and documents used in local government program administration, amending ordinances, various strategies to improve ordinance compliance, and proposed regulatory changes. Upon completion of this course, participants will receive a Penn State certificate verifying the 0.6 CEUs earned toward the Certified Recycling Professional program.

Day Two: Recycling 115 - Public Policy and Sustainable Resource Management

Topics include the history and evolution of solid waste management in Pennsylvania. It will also address factors affecting the future of recycling and public policy. Upon completion of this course, participants will receive a Penn State certificate verifying the 0.3 CEUs earned toward the Certified Recycling Professional program.

Day Two: Recycling 150 - Economic I

Participants will be provided with specific information, tools and strategies to help make their individual re-cycling programs more cost-effective. The instructor will discuss three sections beginning with topics such as: fully understanding costs, using fixed and variable costs to your advantage, which costs you can control and how, what does it cost to collect your recyclables, and full cost accounting principles. The next session will focus on finding and measuring savings to sell the benefits of your program and cost benefits of recycling. The final session will consist of recovering savings, smart contracting and tough negotiation, contract language to save money, market strategies, and market analysis and contracts. Upon completion of this course, participants will receive a Penn State certificate verifying the 0.3 CEUs earned toward the Certified Recycling Professional program.
