What is Farm to Pantry?

Farm to Pantry is a local charitable non-profit providing fresh, affordable food to all members of the community, particularly our most vulnerable.

By organizing volunteers—seniors, students groups, families, residents—and working with local charities and schools, our organization rescues surplus produce to feed and nourish those in need in our community. On the invitation of property owners, we glean wherever there is healthy, fresh produce to be harvested locally and deliver it to over 22 programs in Northern Sonoma County.

We have gleaned and distributed apples, beets, cabbage, cauliflower, figs, greens, grapefruit, kiwis, lemons, peas, peppers, persimmons, spinach, plums, potatoes, pumpkins, oranges, carrots, squash, tomatoes, turnips, walnuts and zucchini—more than 76 crops—all grown in Sonoma County.

Our History

In 2008, Melita Love and two friends noted the abundance of fruits and vegetables that often remained unpicked in our community—produce that was unsold by local farmers as well as the bounty grown in private gardens and decorative landscapes. Recruiting more friends as volunteers and seeking the permission of local residents and farmers, they set out to "glean" this bounty and pass it on to our local food pantry. Since then, Farm to Pantry has grown to include hundreds of volunteers and has harvested and distributed fresh produce through multiple local charities. Today, Farm to Pantry is an established organization managed by its founder and many loyal and enthusiastic supporters and volunteers.
