
## The Ives Park Walk

## "The Blue Line"



- Walk south down Petaluma Ave. Turn right at the Bodega/Sebastopol Ave. intersection. (Or consider the alternate route of the breezeway walking south and then west to Bodega and Main St.
  - Shops and restaurants
- 2. Press the button and use the light to cross Bodega first (careful of cars making a left!)
- 3. Press the button and use the light to cross Main St. Make a left down Main St. walking south.
  - Shops and restaurants
- 4. Turn right (west) up Burnett Ave.
- 5. Cross Burnett heading south in the crosswalk. Then make a right, heading west, and use the crosswalk to get across High St.
- 6. Make a left and soon thereafter a right when you get to the park (large stand of redwoods)
  - Creek and bridges
  - Ives Pool (solar heated!)
  - Outdoor stage

- Sebastopol Center for the Arts
- Picnic tables, BBQ, playground
- Fairy ring of redwoods: Pioneer monument

## Return trip to the Plaza

- 7. Standing in front of the pool, facing south, walk to the right of the building, up the walkway to the sidewalk on Willow St. Or walk to the left of the building and use the stairs.
- 8. Make a left on Willow (heading east) for two blocks. (A bit steep downhill on the last block.)
  - Fish sculpture
  - Quaint houses and gardens
- Views!
- Classic Post Office with WPA mural inside
- 9. Consider using the lights to cross Main St. (east) and check out:
  - Visitor Center

- Western Sonoma County Historical Museum
- 10. Back at the Post Office on Willow St. walk north on Main St. to Burnett. Cross Main St. at the crosswalk and then make a left and cross Burnett continuing north on Main St.
  - Shops and restaurants
- 11. At Bodega Ave, press the button to cross. Return to the Plaza making a right down Bodega Ave. and a left at Petaluma Ave. Or consider the alternate route through the breezeway.
