

The Laguna de Santa Rosa Walk

"The Green Line"



1. Walk east from the Plaza, crossing Petaluma at the crosswalk.
2. Turn left (north), crossing McKinley in the crosswalk.
3. Turn right (east), walking down McKinley to the large green sunken plaza and lawn.
 - Movie theater used to be an apple brandy distillery
 - The Barlow shops
4. Turn left (north) and walk to Laguna Parkway.
 - Living woven-wood fence
5. Turn right at Laguna Parkway and head east to Morris
 - Benches for resting
6. Cross Morris Street (careful of traffic, no crosswalk) and turn left (north). The Laguna is along the right (eastern) side of the sidewalk.
 - Picnic and baseball at Clahan Park
 - Seasonal pontoon bridge
7. Follow Morris St. north to the Community Center's Youth Annex (colorful building with solar panels)
 - Teen Memorial Labyrinth
 - Swallows nesting in the spring
8. Continue walking north into the parking lot (Morris St. turns to the left/west)
 - North entrance to the Laguna, valley views, Mount St. Helena
 - Ponds and abundant birds, plants and wildlife

Return trip to the Plaza

9. Cross Morris St. at the north side of Laguna Parkway (Careful of traffic. No crosswalk)
10. Walk on the north side and turn right to visit the Skate Garden Park.
 - Skateboarders
 - Graffiti artist gallery
 - Community Gardens
11. Exiting the Skate Garden Park, cross Laguna Parkway at the crosswalk and turn right, walking west on the south side of the street until you are back to the Plaza (corner of Laguna Parkway & McKinley).
 - Surfing Dog Sculpture
 - Shady veranda
 - Solar Powered Police Station
