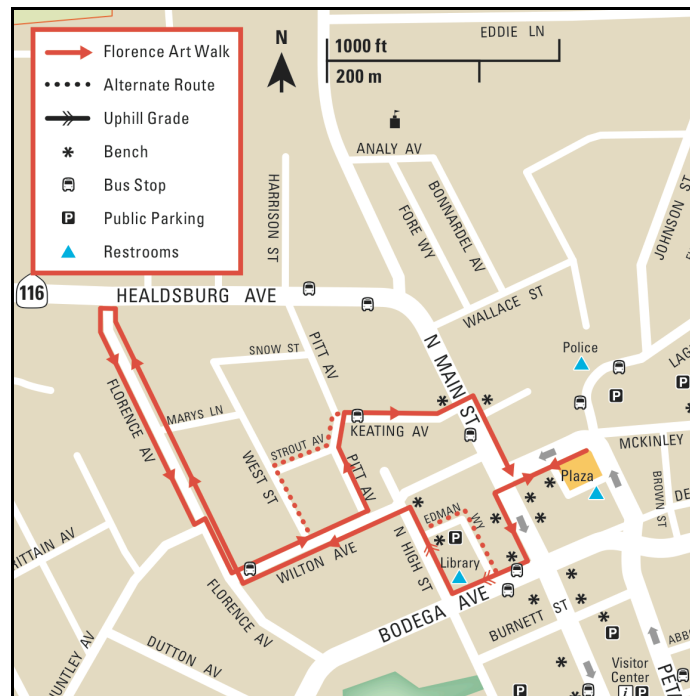


The Florence Avenue Art Walk

"The Red Line"



1. Walk west from the Plaza, up McKinley, crossing Main St. at the traffic light.
 - Coyote Mural
2. Turn left (south), to the corner of N. Main St. and Bodega Ave. (Possible alternate through breezeway at Sebastopol Cookie Company)
 - Shops and restaurants
 - Live theater
3. Turn right (west), walking up Bodega Ave. to High St. (Possible alternate at Edman Parking Lot)
 - Living History Garden
 - City Hall
 - The Library
4. Turn right (north) on High St. and walk to Wilton Ave.
 - Tall stand of redwoods
 - Copper Sculpture
 - Benches for resting
 - Views!
5. Turn left and cross High St. continuing down Wilton Ave. on south side until Florence Ave.
 - Quaint houses
 - Gardens
6. Cross Wilton and walk down Florence Ave. on the east side of the street.
 - Babe Ruth, Batman and many other sculptures
 - Mary's Lane creek
 - Florence Lofts: green building; Work-live studios.
 - Restaurant row on Healdsburg

Return trip to the Plaza

7. Cross Florence Ave. (careful of cars making turns!). Walk back south on the west side of the street.
 - More sculptures
 - Mortarless rock wall (house with Oakland A's player)
8. Turn left, crossing Florence where it meets Huntley. Then right heading south on Florence.
 - Old, old Victorian house (Says 1903 in stained glass window)
9. Make a left, heading east on Wilton (north side of the street)
 - Espaliered apple and pear living fence
 - Views across the valley!
10. Cross Pitt Ave. Make a left (north) down the hill. Cross Keating. Make a right to Main St.
11. Cross Main St. at the flashing light crosswalk, then make a right and walk to McKinley
 - Shops and restaurants
12. Cross McKinley at the traffic light. Then turn left down McKinley to arrive back at the Plaza.
