

UPCOMING WORK In Delaware County

The following work is planned in the Delaware County area on the specified dates and times. All work is weather dependent; it may be postponed or cancelled without prior notice. For up-to-date traffic information, construction information and road conditions, 24-hours a day, visit www.Ohgo.com.

MONDAY, APRIL 4 **U.S. Route 23 – (NEW)** The entrance ramp from SR 37 (Central Avenue) to US 23 north will close for resurfacing. The detour is Central Avenue to N. Sandusky Street to US 23 north. **Completion: April 8.**

THURSDAY, APRIL 7 **State Route 3 – (NEW)** SR 3 will be reduced to one lane of two-way traffic at the Plumb Road intersection from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to install barrier wall. **Completion: April 8.**

SUNDAY, APRIL 10 **Interstate 71 – (NEW)** I-71 will close temporarily in both directions at North Galena Road between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. for utility work. Motorists will be stopped for 5 minutes at a time. A law enforcement officer will assist with traffic control. All lanes will be open by 10 a.m.

TUESDAY, APRIL 12 **Plumb Road – (NEW)** Both directions of Plumb Road will close west of SR 3 for 30 days to install a new traffic signal. The detour is Plumb Road to Worthington Road to Lewis Center Road to SR 3 to Plumb Road or reverse. **Completion: May 11.**

ONGOING

Kilbourne Road – Kilbourne Road will be closed in both directions between SR 61 and SR 521 over I-71 starting at 7 a.m. for bridge work. The detour is SR 61 to SR 521 to North Galena Road or reverse. **Completion: April 2016.**

Galena Road – Galena Road will close over I-71 for a bridge deck replacement. The detour is Galena Road to US 36 to 3 B's and K Road to SR 521 or reverse. **Completion: June 25.**

Sawmill Parkway – Sawmill Parkway will be reduced to one southbound lane at SR 750 beginning at 7 a.m. for road widening project. **Completion: June 30th.**

U.S. Route 23/Pennsylvania Ave

The exit ramp from US 23 southbound to Sandusky St. will close at 9 a.m. and remain closed until Labor Day. The closure is necessary so crews can construct a new ramp serving the north end of the city. When it re-opens late August, weather permitting, the ramp will accommodate two-way traffic on Sandusky Street to the intersection of US 23. Additionally, US 23 northbound traffic will have a turn lane and traffic signal to access N. Sandusky St. The US 23 northbound entrance ramp will remain open during construction. **Completion: Labor Day 2016**
