




HSN participants lead inquiry and sustainable project-based learning initiatives in their school communities, and share their stories to support and inspire others. Funded projects positively impact students both directly (i.e. student leadership) and indirectly (i.e. positive changes to the school environment).











HSN Grants – School Type Distribution
