SNAP Benefit Dates Are Changing

Right now, SNAP benefits are issued in the first 10 days of each month. Beginning in August, SNAP benefits will be issued over a longer number of days. This change is being made so that grocery stores can offer a wider range of food, like fresh fruit and vegetables, all month long.

To make this change easier on some households, the shift in benefit date will be completed over a 2 month period, August and September.

Beginning in September, SNAP benefits will be issued from the 1st through the 19th of each month.

Only the date you receive your SNAP benefits on your EBT card is changing. You will keep the same card and PIN you are using now.

The charts below show the change in dates for both August and September.

AUGUST

The date you receive your benefits is based on your SNAP case number.

- 1. Find your SNAP case number that is listed at the top of this notice.
- 2. The date benefits are issued is based on the LAST NUMBER of the case number.
- 3. The last column of this chart shows the date benefits will be issued in AUGUST.
