



The DFB on the move



- 30 DFB info vans supported more than 20,000 events hosted by clubs over a three-year period (May 2009 April 2015).
- With an average 50 attendants per event (club board members, coaches, parents, children), some 1.000,000 people received training over a six-year period; of those, 200,000 were coaches.
- Every DFB info van covers some 120 clubs per year, which roughly equates with three clubs per week.
- Budget:1.000,000 € / year




