



2015 TRAIL CLOSURES & DETOURS *Information*

Dear Bicycle Commuters:

We would like to inform you about various trail closures and recommended detours throughout the metro area. This information is certainly not meant to be all-inclusive: rather, it's the best information we have to date. We'll update this document as we receive new information. Contact your city or county public works department for more information.

Adams County

The Clear Creek Trail will be closed at 64th Avenue for approximately one year beginning January 12, 2015. The trail closure is due to the closure of 64th Avenue to construct a bridge over the RTD Northwest Rail Line and BNSF railroad tracks. More information can be found [here](#).

The Sprat Platte Fishing Facility in Thornton is closed for construction. As a result, there are S. Platte Trail detours in that area. More information can be found [here](#).

Toll Gate Creek Trail (ongoing) – The northern portion of the Toll Gate Creek Trail adjacent to Fitzsimons Parkway from Montview Blvd. north through Sand Creek Park, 2700 N. Peoria St., is closed to accommodate construction of the Aurora commuter rail line/I-225 rail project. Pedestrians and cyclists should use the sidewalks along Colfax Avenue and Peoria Street as a detour. Please use caution and observe all trail closures through Sand Creek Park. High Line Canal Trail (intermittent) – The High Line Canal at Second and Abilene will have periodic closures near the credit union building due to I-225 rail line construction. RTD has assured the City of

Aurora that the trail will be kept open for Bike to Work Day. Please use caution when traveling in this area.

High Line Canal/Sand Creek Trail connections (intermittent) – There are closures and detours, north of Springhill Park, June 1 through November 1, 2015.
