

Jewish athletes ages 12 thru 16 as of July 31, 2016 are eligible to play! Don't miss this opportunity to compete against delegates from cities across the United States as well as other countries, including Israel.

Compete in one of eight sports: baseball, basketball, soccer, volleyball, tennis, golf, swimming and **table tennis** or participate as a **Star Reporter**, while sharing in a cultural exchange with teens experiencing Columbus for the first time. Families of local athletes must need to provide accommodations for at least two athletes in their home.

The Games include a community service project called JCC Cares. This allows athletes to participate in a hands-on service project to give back to the community in a meaningful way.

Sign up today! The Games are open to all current JCC members and non-JCC members. Non-JCC members that register to participate receive a complimentary JCC membership valid through the end of July 2016!

Also, for kids ages 8-11, the Jr. Maccabi Games are another fun way to stay connected to the competition.

Visiting athletes stay in homes of local Jewish families. Welcome JCC Maccabi athletes into your home for the week of July 24-29 (five nights). "Home hospitality" is vital to the experience, representing the extended family and Jewish value of welcoming the stranger.

All Team Columbus JCC Maccabi Games local delegation athletes must be able to house a minimum of two visiting athletes. Each athlete must have his/her own bed. (Air matteress are acceptable.)

Host families provide a Jewish home, daily meals, access to laundry facilities and also provide transportation to and from the JCC or conveniently located drop-off/ pick-up points.
