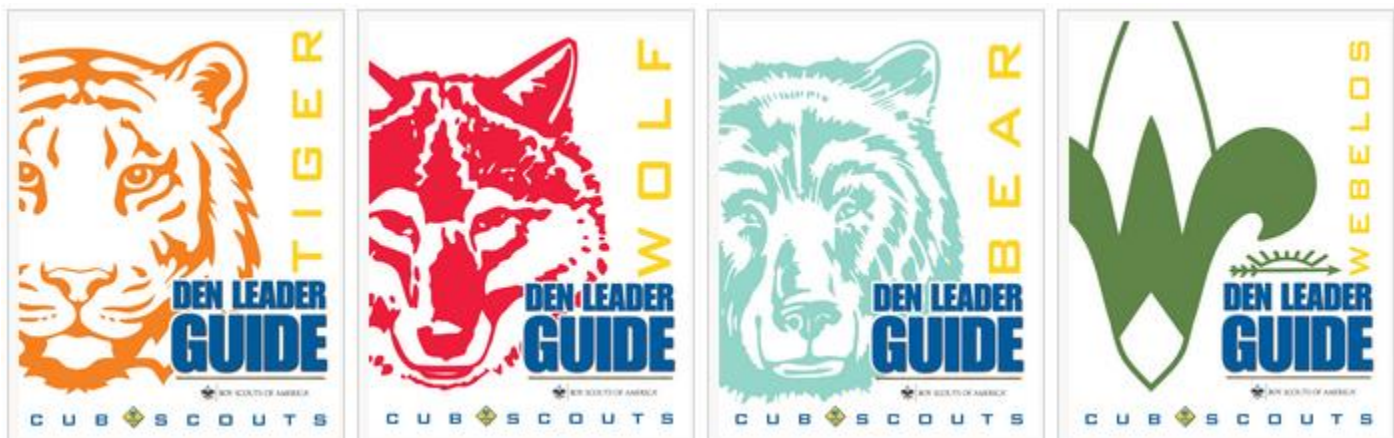


Online Training for New Cub Scouting Program

The online training for den leaders, Cubmasters, committee chairs/members and charter organization representatives has been updated with shorter, more targeted modules so leaders can get the training they need, in the order they want, any time they need it. The new training is organized into time-based sections: the learning needed prior to the first meeting, within the first 30 days, and training needed to be considered position-specific “trained”.
