

DRAFT 3-D Printer User Agreement 1/29/14HWJD

The Hamilton-Wenham Public Library provides access to technological resources including a MakerBot 3-D Printer purchased by The Friends of the Hamilton-Wenham Public Library.

Patrons may use library computers at any time to design objects to print with the 3-D printer. However, they must make an appointment to print their objects. In January 2014, patrons may sign up to use the 3-D printer on Monday afternoons from 1-5.

All patrons must have a valid library card, agree to comply with the User Agreement, show staff the STL file to be printed and include a description of the project to be printed. Patrons under 18 should be accompanied by a supervising adult. Users agree to pay a materials fee of \$3.00 for standard print jobs. (Jobs using large amounts of materials will require a \$5.00 fee).

The Hamilton-Wenham Public Library reserves the right to refuse content of any project at any time at the discretion of Library staff. Examples of specific content that will not be produced include but are not limited to:

1. Content that incorporates sexually explicit material, or infringes upon the safety and security of minors.
2. Content that may be construed as having intent to harm.
3. Content that may infringe upon the intellectual property rights of a third party.
4. Objects that are too large to print within the scheduled time frame. (These objects may be scheduled for another time.)

By submitting content, the patron agrees to assume all responsibility for, and shall hold the library harmless in, all matters related to patented, trademarked, or copyrighted materials.

The Hamilton-Wenham Public Library is not responsible for any damage, loss, or security of data arising from the use of its computers or network, nor for the functionality or quality of content produced on the 3-D Printer.

Disclaimer: While the library staff members make every effort to oversee the use the 3-D Printer, neither the library staff nor the town is responsible for any object created with the use of the 3-D printer, including any harm or injury incurred as a result of any usage of the 3-D printer.
