New website focuses on local food in Napa County

(NAPA, California) The Napa County Agricultural Commissioner's Office and the Napa Local Food Advisory Council are unveiling NapaLocalFood.com to connect residents with information about local food issues.

The new website, which was designed over three years, allows users to learn more about local food resources and where to find locally grown and sustainable food, among other resources.

NapaLocalFood.com is a hub of information that includes a list of local growers, retailers, farm stands, farmers markets and community supported agriculture. There's also information about community groups that run food banks, gardens and sustainable agriculture programs.

There is also a link to the Local Food Council's land bank project and survey. The council aims to promote local food production by encouraging landowners to consider converting a piece of their property into food farming.

The Local Food Advisory Council advises the Agricultural Commissioner and Board of Supervisors on issues related to developing and promoting a sustainable local food system in Napa County.
