**Please plan to arrive a little early to register & warm up. All tryouts will start promptly on times stated. Participants only need to plan to be available during their group's time slot.**

## **Baseball Tryout Information:**

- All players league age 9 through 12 must attend one of the two tryout dates listed below.
- If you are a returning player to a Major Division team, you do not have to attend tryouts.
- \*\*\*Trying Out for Majors does not guarantee you will be drafted into the Major League\*\*\*
- Players who try out for Majors and are not drafted on a Majors team will be automatically entered in the AAA draft.

## **Softball Tryout Information:**

- All players league age 9 through 12 must attend one of the two tryout dates listed below.
- Any girl wishing to waive up in a division must complete a waiver request form and receive approval from the Board.

**1st Tryout:** When: Saturday, February 20, 2016

Where: Lebanon High School **Auxiliary Gym**

Time: Boys Majors/AAA (10-12:30pm)

Girls 12U[Majors] & 10U[Minors] (1:30-3pm)

**2nd Tryout:** When: Saturday, Feb 27, 2016

Where: Lebanon High School **Auxiliary Gym**

Time: Girls 12U[Majors] & 10U[Minors] (10-11:30am)

Boys Majors/AAA (12:30-3pm)

- The gym (or surrounding hallways) will be available for one ½ hour prior to each start time for players to stretch and prepare for their evaluations.

- All players participating in the evaluations should wear comfortable sports clothing including tennis shoes/running shoes. **NO CLEATS.** They should bring their bat, glove, and helmet - these items will be available if you do not own one. Parents should also bring their child's completed Medical Release and Information form if they have not submitted it already.
- Players will be asked to participate in a series of drills to test for various athletic abilities:

Speed / Fielding Grounders & Pop Ups / Arm Strength & Accuracy / Pitching & Hitting Mechanics

- Players will be evaluated by prospective team managers and coaches. The length of the evaluation process will be determined by the number of players who attend each session. Please be prepared to stay for the full time of your division's evaluation.
- If you are unable to attend evaluations, your child can still be drafted onto a team.
