A HEAT WAVE HAS BEEN PREDICTED FOR THE UPPER FRASER VALLEY OVER THE NEXT TWO WEEKS WITH AT LEAST ONE DAY AT 39 DEGREES C (107 DEGREES F) THIS EVENT MAY HAVE A DEVISTATING AFFECT ON OUR HOMELESS AND OTHERS WHO DO NOT HAVE THE MEANS TO KEEP THEMSELVES HYDRATED. SEVERE DEYDRATION MAY LEAD TO UNCONCIOUSNESS AND IN SOME CASES DEATH.

GRIFFIN SECURITY IS ASKING FOR THE PUBLICS HELP IN OBTAINING CASES OF WATER. EACH OF THE 11 GRIFFIN SECUIRTY VEHICLES WILL THEN CARRY AND DISTRIBUTE WATER TO ANYONE IN NEED DURING OUR PATROLS OF CHILLIWACK.

ANYONE WISHING TO DONATE A CASE OF WATER CAN DROP IT OFF A THE GRIFFIN SECURITY OFFICES 9300 NOWELL ST. CHILLIWACK OR CALL 604-703-0888 AND ONE OF THE SECURITY VEHICLES WILL PICK UP THE WATER FROM ANY LOCATION IN CHILLIWACK.
