School Transit Subsidy Program Overview

- **To provide free or reduced fare transportation for District of Columbia school students who ride Metrobus, Metrorail, or DC Circulator to/from school and for educational trips.**

Eligibility Requirements

- **Must be between the ages of 5-21**
- **Be enrolled in a public, charter, private school, or parochial school within the District of Columbia**
- **Must be a District resident**
- **DC Foster Youth up to the age of 21**
- **Students with disabilities up to the age of 22**

DC One Card Registration Instructions

1. Request a DC One Card from your School ID administrator (If you do not have one)
2. Students must have a valid email address (Note: The email address cannot be used twice)
3. Go to the DC One Card website: <http://www.dconecard.dc.gov>
4. On the main DC One Card website, look for the “Register/Manage Your DC One Card” tab and click on the link.
5. Click on the “Register” button
6. Fill out the required information
7. Afterwards, confirm your email address, establish a password and set your secret questions.
8. Check your email account for a DC One Card confirmation link. Click on the link to confirm your email.
9. Sign in using your email address and your previously established password
10. Once you have signed in, scroll down the page to Student Transit Subsidy section and click “Check Your Eligibility” to enroll in the Transit Subsidy Program to receive Benefits.

****Students must wait 3 business days (Monday-Friday) before Tapping their DC One Card on Metrobus and DC Circulator**

****Students must wait 24 Hours before Tapping their DC One Card on Metrorail**

****Until the FREE pass loads onto the DC One Card, a student must pay to ride.**
