Suspicious Incidents Near Palm Crest Elementary School

Incident One: On June 3, 2013, at approximately 2:00 PM, a student was walking home from school in the area of Palm Drive and Orchard Lane when a male asked him to help retrieve his dog from the street.

Suspect Description: Male White, with a goatee.

Vehicle: Light colored late model Toyota Camry.

Incident Two: On June 7, 2013, at approximately 3:00 PM, a student was walking home from school near Palm Drive and Lombardy Drive when the student was approached by two males who offered the student a ride home and a bunny Pez dispenser. When the student refused, the males told the student they had an "X-Box."

Suspect Description: Passenger is a Male Hispanic or White, approximately 13-16 years old. The victim was unable to see the driver.

Vehicle: White 4-door sedan with beige interior.
