### Eligibility

The "2016 Teen Video Challenge" for OREGON is open only to legal U.S. residents who are residents of OREGON aged 13-18. Participants are ineligible if directly related to the panel of judges for the contest. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Contest Rules.

Each participant or group may submit one video per entry. Each entry must include signed model release form(s). All submissions must be postmarked by **March 14, 2016**. Late entries will not be accepted. A DVD of the video will be requested from the winner.

### Terms and Conditions

All audio and artwork must be created by the entrant or be in the public domain and must be specified as such on the entry form. CSLP (and all CSLP member affiliates) have permission to use the "2016 Teen Video Challenge" submissions, including all work created and all intellectual property embodied therein, as per the Contest Release form.

### Video Criteria for Acceptance

All videos must:

- Be 30 to 90 seconds.
- Promote the idea of using public libraries and reading.
- Include your interpretation of the 2016 CSLP teen slogan "Get in the Game: READ."
- Be designed for use at **any** library.
- Be appropriate for viewing by audiences of all ages.

#### Video will be judged on the following criteria

- ◆ Creativity
- ◆ Message clarity and relevance
- ◆ Motivation and inspiration
- ◆ Overall impact

2. **Create** your video.
3. **Title** your video with: "2016 TVC - [State Abbreviation] - [Unique Name]." Please choose a name that does not include your real name.
4. **Upload** your video to **YouTube.com** or **Vimeo.com**.
5. **Fill out and get signatures** for your completed Entry & Model Release form(s).

### Winners and Prizes

CSLP will review all state winners during April 2016. In the spring of 2016, CSLP will award each CSLP approved State Teen Video Challenge Winner \$150. Their local Public Library will receive prizes worth at least \$50 from CSLP and Upstart.

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## Model Release Form for Publication and Video Purposes for the Teen Video Challenge

This release is a binding contract between the undersigned and Collaborative Summer Library Program ("CSLP"). It insures to the benefit of and binds both parties' heirs, successors, representatives and assigns.

**Each member of a team that submits a video or, who appears in the video, must sign a release.**

Subject of Release. "Material" refers to all video, images, photographs, mixed media, music, text and other forms of copyrighted material that I supply to CSLP.

License. I grant CSLP an irrevocable, perpetual, world-wide, royalty-free, sub-licensable, transferable, non-exclusive license to use, reproduce, distribute, publish, prepare derivative works, display, perform, and otherwise exploit the Material in any media form.

Name and Likeness. I grant CSLP an irrevocable, perpetual, world-wide, royalty-free license to use my name and likeness, image, voice in the Material as well as my biographical information for advertising, publicity, trade or any other lawful purpose.

No 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Copyrighted Material. I agree that the Material I submit does not include any copyrighted material belonging to someone else unless it is in the public domain.

No Obligation to Use and No Right to Review. I understand that CSLP is under no obligation to use the Material. I understand that I do not have a right to inspect and approve the finished product or such written or spoken copy used in connection with the finished product.

Consideration. I understand and agree that the sole consideration offered by CSLP is the evaluation of the Material for its potential use, and acknowledge the receipt and adequacy of this consideration.

Indemnity. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless CSLP, its officers, directors, employees and agents from any actual or alleged claims that arise from the licensed use of this Material including without limitation any claim of infringement, defamation or any breach of my representations or warranties.
