



## Yellow Ribbon Reintegration Program

### Tutoring Services

Online tutoring services provided through Tutor.com are temporarily suspended for Reserve Component (RC) members, who are not currently on Active Duty, and their families. Services remain in place for Active Duty personnel (including Active Guard/Reserve members), RC members who are currently activated, Wounded Warriors, Survivors, deployed Department of Defense civilians, and their families. Efforts are underway to restore online tutoring services for RC members and their families, but no firm date for reactivation is currently available.

#### **Veterans Affairs Tutorial Assistance ([www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/tutorial\\_assistance.asp](http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/tutorial_assistance.asp))**

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) provides tutorial assistance for students using GI Bill benefits. The following criteria must be met for a student to be eligible for tutorial assistance:

- The student must be in a post-secondary program half time or more. For the Post-9/11 GI Bill, rate of pursuit must be at least 50 percent.
- The student must have a deficiency in a course that is part of his or her approved program.
- The student must be enrolled in the course during the quarter, semester, or term in which the tutoring is received for the course. Tutoring may not occur between quarters or semesters.

The student, tutor, and certifying official must complete VA Form 22-1990t, Application and Enrollment Certification for Individualized Tutorial Assistance. The application may be submitted at the end of each month or combination of months. The application must be signed and dated on or after the date of the last tutoring session certified.

#### **Tutor Chat Live ([www.tutorchatlive.org](http://www.tutorchatlive.org))**

Tutor Chat Live provides access to free, live, online tutoring and fosters an online academic community. Students register, log in, and select from a list of subject areas. If there are tutors online for the subject of interest, the student can choose to chat with those available. The program does not have pre-set curricula or time limits for tutoring sessions. Tutors guide students through their homework questions. To ensure students understand classroom concepts and they can apply the material going forward, tutors quiz students at the end of each chat.



Tutor Chat Live tutors are certified and background-checked by the Tutor Chat Live Foundation. The program was founded by students of the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania and is supported by tutors at universities across the nation.

**Learn To Be ([www.learntobe.org](http://www.learntobe.org))**

Learn To Be provides no-cost tutoring services through a customized, online classroom environment. Students can request sessions in math, sciences, and language arts between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Pacific Time. The service is completely free and is supported by the Learn To Be Foundation, which operates solely on donations from the community.

Learn To Be tutors are certified and background-checked by the foundation prior to entering the tutoring program. University chapters throughout the United States, including Cornell University, University of Michigan, and University of California-Los Angeles, support the foundation.
